Vote for Antonio "Toz" Piretti to play his music in the TTC

Italian-born Antonio "Toz" Piretti has been making music ever since coming to Canada in 2009. He started busking at the local TTC station and began working seriously as an Indie rock singer/songwriter. Since then, he has released three albums and performed at hundreds of gigs across Canada, including as part of a <u>cross-country</u> tour he did to celebrate Canada 150.

Back from his tour, Piretti is now competing for a chance to play in Toronto's subway system for the next three years. From May 7 to June 3, you can vote once per day for Piretti at <u>undergroundsounds.ca</u>. Ninety musicians will be licensed to play in the subway.

"When I arrived in Toronto as an immigrant in 2009, this was my challenge, to live or 'survive' with my music, and I succeeded playing in the subway of Toronto with a regular licence every day for the first two years," Piretti says. "Now, I'd like to go back to have that licence and this result depends on your support in voting for me."
